RESOLUTION

Re: Request by the Leadership of the Communist Party of Argentina

- 1. (It is hereby resolved to) grant the request of the Leadership of the Communist Party of Argentina that we arrange for a CPA functionary a 3-month special course in clandestine party techniques, in 1980.
- 2. This training course shall be the responsibility of the KGB, USSR; the accommodation, housing, and other assistance shall be the responsibility of the International Department and the Department of Administrative Affairs, CC CPSU, with all attendant expenses, including Buenos-Aires-Moscow and back fares, to be charged to the party budget's reserve expense accounts.

The Leadership of the Communist Party of Argentina has requested CC CPSU (as per OP#1749) that a trusted CPA representative can undergo a special course of training, of up to three months, in clandestine party operations.

We believe it worthwhile to grant the CPA Leadership's request and arrange, in 1980, for a three-month course of training in clandestine party techniques for this CPA representative.

This training course could be organized by the Committee for State Security of the USSR, while the CC CPUS International Department and the Department of Administrative Affairs could take care of his accommodation and housing arrangements, with all expenses, including those involved in his transportation from Buenos-Aires to Moscow and back, his stay in the USSR, charged to the party budget reserve expense items.

This matter has been coordinated with the KGB of the USSR (Comrade Chebrikov).
